The Maui Puerto Rican Association is pleased to announce the availability of five scholarship awards in the amount of \$1,000 each for post-secondary academic and/or vocational education.

High school seniors planning to continue their education and adult students already enrolled in accredited post-secondary educational institutions who are of Puerto Rican or part-Puerto Rican ancestry are invited to apply for the scholarship grants.

During the course of their studies, awardees are required to list Maui County as their permanent residence.

In addition to a completed and signed application, applicants are **required** to furnish the following:

1. A high school transcript or a transcript of the most recently completed semester in a post-secondary institution.
2. Two letters of reference from persons other than relatives.
3. An essay, not longer than one page, explaining the applicant's reason(s) for applying for this particular scholarship. Your application will receive a lower score if the essay exceeds one page.

Signed applications and required documents must be postmarked not later than March 31, 2023 to be considered.

Applicants may be required to appear for an interview with the selection sub-committee. Announcement of awards will be made in June and awards will be presented in the summer of 2023.

In either case, applications and essays must be submitted **no later than March 31, 2023.**

**All required documents must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2023:**

1. A high school transcript or current grade point average from present educational institution.
2. Two letters of reference from adults not related to you, who have a sound understanding of your capabilities. References may be obtained from persons such as teachers, counselors, employers, supervisors or ministers. Please do not send photos.
3. A personal essay not longer than one page, explaining why you are applying for this particular scholarship. (The personal essay may be submitted Online.) Your application will receive lower scores if your essay exceeds one page.
4. **If your Essay, Transcripts or reference letters are not post marked by March 31, 2023, your application will not be considered.**
